



Jesusito Morillos is both a lawyer and a civil engineer. He is the Chairman of the Philippine Institute of Arbitrators (PIArb, 2022-2023; Past President, 2020-2021), and the Chairman of the Rule Change Committee of the Wholesale Electricity Spot Market (WESM, 2022- ; WESM's past Dispute Resolution Administrator, 2011-2021). He is a past Chairman of the 9-countries-strong Regional Arbitral Institute Forum (RAIF, 2021), a past President of the Philippine Institute of Construction Arbitrators and Mediators (PICAM, 2018-2019). He is a senior partner of the Folloso Morillos & Herce Law Firm (FMH, 1997-present), and Senior Construction Law Consultant to Legal Informatics, Inc. (2022–present).

He is the only speaker from Asia in the *Session No. 5: Adjudication* of the recently concluded UNCITRAL Colloquium on Possible Future Work on Dispute Settlement held from 28 March to 1 April 2022 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York and online.

He is an accredited Arbitrator of the Philippine Dispute Resolution Center (PDRCI, 2004-present), the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission (CIAC, 2008-present), and the Philippine International Center for Conflict Resolution (PICCR, 2019-present). His expertise are in construction, energy, PPP and property development.

He has been appointed arbitrator in an ICC arbitration seated in Singapore and in more than 80 arbitrations in the Philippines. He has acted as counsel in a number of arbitrations before the Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) and the Hong Kong International Arbitration Center (HKIAC) as well as in almost a hundred arbitrations in the Philippines. He has also appeared as party representative in an *Originating Summons* (application for setting aside an Arbitral Award) case before the Singapore International Commercial Court (SICC).

He has been appointed *Dispute Board* member in a number of infrastructure projects, and has been so nominated in several other projects, in the Philippines.

He is a member of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CIArb), the Society of Construction Law (SCL) both of UK and of Singapore, and the Dispute Resolution Board Foundation (DRBF).
