Notes: In 2007, he was elected Representative of the Second District of Cagayan de Oro City in the 14<sup>th</sup> Congress where he had a perfect attendance. He was re-elected last May 10, 2010 elections with a winning margin of 100,000 votes over his opponent. In the 15<sup>th</sup> Congress, he ranks No. 1 among 285 Congressmen in the number of bills and resolutions filed. He has principally authored or co-authored 1,090 house bills and resolutions, of which 31 had become Republic Acts, making him No. 1 of the 285 Congressmen with the most number of bills that have become law. He also had a perfect attendance. He was reelected for a third term in May 2013, winning by 70,000 votes over his closest opponent. He also has perfect attendance and is No. 1 among 291 Congressmen with the most number of bills filed (783 bills and resolutions) and most number of bills that have become Republic Acts. In 2019, he was elected back to the House of Representatives representing the 2<sup>nd</sup> District of Cagayan de Oro City. Last November 18, 2020, he was nominated and elected as Deputy Speaker of the House of Representatives. He was re-elected for his 5<sup>th</sup> term as Representative of the 2<sup>nd</sup> District of Cagayan de Oro City last May 2022. He is No. 1 in bills and resolution filed in the 19<sup>th</sup> Congress as of Dec 31, 2023.

Since 2007, he held a perfect attendance record in the House of Representatives and has consistently topped the ranks for most bills and resolutions principally authored. He is happily married to Fenina Tiukinhoy and very proud of her daughter Regine Beatrice.
