PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND:

Atty. Julius Anthony R. Omila has been a legal practitioner for almost 29 years now and has already focused his practice on arbitration and alternative dispute resolution (ADR).

Since his admission to the Philippine Bar in 1994, he has successfully represented individual and major corporate clients in their various business and government transactions and cases involving civil, commercial, construction, telecommunications, and power issues, among others. He has also served as mediation/ negotiation counsel, arbitration counsel and as

arbitrator in cases involving similar matters. He regularly attends trainings and conferences to further hone his skills and gain accreditations in various dispute resolution institutions both here and abroad.

He presently serves as the Chairman of the Philippine Institute of Arbitrators (PIArb), the first learned society of arbitration and ADR practitioners in the Philippines. He is also a member and accredited arbitrator of the Philippine Dispute Resolution Center, Inc. (PDRCI). Likewise, he is currently the Deputy Secretary General for Business Development (former Corporate Secretary) and an accredited arbitrator of the Philippine International Center for Conflict Resolution (PICCR). He is also a member of the Committee on Amendments of Law formed by the Philippine Institute of Construction Arbitrators and Mediators (PICAM) tasked to review and propose amendments to domestic construction arbitration legislation.

Atty. Omila taught Arbitration and Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) at the Adamson University, College of Law, and is a regular lecturer of the University of the Philippines Institute for the Administration of Justice (UP IAJ) and Integrated Bar of the Philippines (IBP), among others, on Arbitration and ADR, in their Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) programs. In 2012, he was admitted as a Member of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CIArb), East Asia Branch, Philippine Chapter. He is a member of the Philippine Institute of Construction Arbitrators and Mediators (PICAM) and an accredited arbitrator of both the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission (CIAC). He is a member of the Technical Working Group spearheaded by Department of Justice- Office for Alternative Dispute Resolution (DOJ-OADR), Philippine Institute of Arbitrators (PIArb) & Philippine Dispute Resolution Center, Inc. (PDRCI) tasked to review and propose revisions to Philippine Arbitration and ADR Laws.

He is also an accredited arbitrator and mediator of the Wholesale Electricity Spot Market (WESM). He is a regular lecturer of the University of the Philippines Institute for the Administration of Justice (UP IAJ) and the Integrated Bar of the Philippines (IBP), among others, on Arbitration and ADR, in their Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) programs.

Atty. Omila is a member of the Dispute Resolution Board Foundation (DRBF) and has attended the DRBF Administration & Practice Workshop sponsored by the DRBF and Philippine Institute of Construction Arbitrators and Mediators (PICAM). He also attended the FIDIC Academy workshops conducted for the Philippine Institute of Construction Arbitrators and Mediators on (a) Practical Use of FIDIC Conditions of Contracts and the Management of Claims and Resolution of Disputes under FIDIC Conditions of Contracts and the (b) Roles and responsibilities of DAB/ DB under FIDIC Rainbow Suite 1999 and MDB Harmonised Edition 2019. Likewise, he attended the Dispute Board Workshop co-sponsored by the Dispute Resolution Board Foundation (DRBF), and the International Chamber of Commerce Philippines last July 1-2, 2019.

Atty. Omila is a Council member of the Society of Construction Law Philippines (SCLP). He also underwent intensive training in Private Mediation as a scholar of the Department of Justice, Office for Alternative Dispute Resolution (DOJ-OADR) and also recently finished a course on commercial mediation conducted by the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (CI Arb). He also attended the Dispute Board Workshop co-sponsored by the Dispute Resolution Board Foundation (DRBF), and the International Chamber of Commerce Philippines last July 1-2, 2019.

Arbitration and ADR (Alternative Dispute Resolution)

Among his notable works in Arbitration and ADR are the following:

1. He is currently a tribunal member in an arbitration before the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission (CIAC) involving a construction dispute in the Visayas with parties' claims/ counterclaims amounting to several billions of pesos.
2. He is currently a tribunal member in a Philippine Dispute Resolution Center, Inc. (PDRCI) arbitration involving a major government procurement project.
3. He recently served as the chairman in a commercial arbitration administered by the Philippine International Center for Conflict Resolution (PICCR) involving a major domestic courier company and a counterparty which is involved in e-commerce business.
4. He recently served as a panel member in two (2) separate construction disputes, one between a contractor and a private concessionaire operating a railway transportation system, and the other one between a major construction outfit and a subcontractor involving a big construction project in Bonifacio Global City, Taguig.
5. He served as Chairman of an Arbitral Tribunal in an ad hoc arbitration involving a Claimant which is engaged in electronic commerce and runs an online shopping platform, on one hand, and a counter-party which is involved in international and domestic freight forwarding, third party logistics and distribution and cargo services, on the other hand.
6. He served as co-counsel for a domestic corporation in a dispute against a major distributor of electricity involving passed on charges in the supply of electricity, more particularly the imposition of the Fuel Cost Recovery Adjustment (FCRA).
7. He is currently the retained counsel of a domestic corporation which is a party to a construction/ arbitration dispute involving the installation and construction of high-capacity domestic fiber-optic telecommunications submarine network that will connect various islands in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao, which is reported to be

“the country’s longest submarine fiber cable network spanning 2,500 kilometers, about the same distance between Manila and Singapore.”

8. He served as retained counsel of a power transmission company and successfully represented the latter in a number of major negotiations resulting to the settlement of unpaid power and related bills amounting to several millions of pesos. He also successfully collected substantial sums of money for the same company by pursuing a multi-tiered negotiation-mediation-litigation approach against another debtor company.
9. He served as an independent legal expert tasked to render a legal opinion on the dispute between a commercial contractor and a private concessionaire operating a railway transportation system.
10. He is a counsel for a domestic corporation which initiated before the Regional Trial Courts a petition to vacate a domestic arbitral award rendered in a PDRCI-administered commercial arbitration where majority of the arbitrators awarded one billion and eight hundred million pesos (P1,800,000.00) approximately in favor of the respondent in that arbitration. He is also representing the same domestic corporation in opposing the prematurely filed petition for the confirmation of the same arbitral award.
11. He is also the counsel for the same domestic corporation which sought for the discharge of an interim measure of protection which garnished the corporation’s funds amounting to one billion and eight hundred million pesos (P1,800,000.00) approximately.
12. He served as a member of a three (3)- member arbitral panel in an ad hoc arbitration between a private concessionaire and a government- owned and controlled corporation operating a railway transportation system.
13. He served as counsel for the biggest local movie and entertainment outfit which successfully obtained an interim measure of protection before the Regional Trial Courts against a popular actress and entertainer in relation to their agency and management agreement.
14. He is currently a member of an arbitral tribunal in a domestic ad hoc arbitration involving a domestic commercial dispute.
15. He served as a panel member in two (2) separate and recently-concluded construction disputes before the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission (CIAC).
16. He served as a member of an arbitral tribunal which issued its arbitral award in a CIAC (Construction Industry Arbitration Commission) arbitration between a private contractor and a

government agency involving a big government-sponsored construction project.

17. He was the chairman of the arbitral tribunal of a PDRCI-administered commercial arbitration where the subject dispute involved the sale and purchase of a domestic commercial enterprise worth more than a billion pesos and where the parties duly complied with the award within a week after it was issued by the tribunal.
18. He was a member of an arbitral panel in a CIAC arbitration involving international parties and where the dispute was related to the construction and commissioning, among others, of a solar power plant here in the Philippines.
19. He was the tribunal chairman in an ad hoc commercial arbitration and also a member of the arbitral panel in a construction arbitration before the Construction Industry Arbitration Commission (CIAC), where the respective tribunals issued their final awards in August and September 2018, respectively.
20. He has successfully represented a major commercial bank in an international commercial arbitration wherein he secured, in behalf of his client, an interim measure of protection in aid of arbitration against a joint-venture involving local and foreign I.T. companies.
21. He also assisted the same client in a private commercial mediation wherein the respondent amicably settled their substantial obligations with the client-bank.
22. He has participated in various mediation and negotiation proceedings involving major construction, commercial, labor and property disputes of both individual and corporate clients.
23. He represented a major construction company engaged in the construction of a popular shopping mall in Mindanao in a negotiation for the settlement of the claims filed against it by several hundreds of its hired workers.
24. Likewise, he successfully negotiated in behalf of a domestic corporation the settlement of a property dispute involving a resort in the Visayas without the parties having to resort to court litigation.
25. He is regularly being consulted by both public and private entities on construction disputes.

Court litigation

Among Atty. Omila's notable works in litigation are the following:

1. As a former external counsel of a power transmission company, he successfully handled civil actions for sum of money, breach of contract and damages in behalf of the former, thus allowing his client to collect from its customers substantial amounts covering accumulated unpaid obligations, with corresponding interest.
2. As a former accredited external counsel of a major commercial bank, he was able to recover possession of prime properties in behalf of the latter.
3. He has represented various construction companies in their legal disputes, including one which involved the construction of an international airport and proper application thereto of procurement law and rules.
4. He has also successfully handled insurance cases in behalf of one of the biggest insurance companies in the country.
5. For several years, he also served as retained counsel of a major agricultural company in the latter's cases aimed at protecting its leasehold rights over thousands of hectares of public land in Mindanao and its hundreds of millions of pesos' worth of private investments thereon against illegal claimants.
6. He also successfully represented a major real estate company before the trial and appellate courts in cases involving almost a hundred hectares of residential and commercial properties subject of a joint venture agreement.
7. He has represented a foreign wildlife conservation entity in prosecuting a criminal case against a foreign national and his Filipino cohort for embezzlement of donated funds.
8. He has also handled criminal cases in behalf of major companies involved in telecommunications and shipping businesses.
